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ABOUT CMIT

Chesapeake Math and IT Academy (CMIT) is a Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics (STEAM) public charter school in northern Prince George's County that aims to serve grades 6 through 12 with an academic program focusing on mathematics and information technologies. As stated in our mission statement, CMIT partners with students, parents and the community, to attain educational excellence by providing a rigorous and technology-integrated education for middle and high school students with an emphasis on mathematics, science, and information technologies. The school was opened in the Fall of 2012, and graduated its first senior class in June 2017 with a 100% graduation rate and a 100% college acceptance rate. Students are enrolled through a public lottery process, open to all students living in Prince Georges County Maryland. Due to the school's advanced curriculum, middle school students can earn high school credit earlier, allowing them to pursue more rigorous coursework throughout their years in high school.

THE ITEC PROGRAM

CMIT offers the Information Technology Early College program, also known as ITEC, a dual enrollment program offered in partnership with Prince George's Community College (PGCC). This is a grant-funded program that responds to the identified need to increase opportunities for high school students to earn college credits and/or industry certifications in STEM fields. Students in our ITEC program graduate high school with both a high school diploma and an Associate's Degree in Information Technology.
