Your assignment will have three parts: (398 points total)

1. Introduction to Period 1: 1491-1607 (113 points total) **Due: September 7**
  - Read Chapter 1 “A New World of Many Cultures, 1491-1607” and complete the provided notes worksheet. (91 points total)
  - Period 1 Primary Source Documents (22 points total)  
Read the two provided documents and 1 image in order to
    - Complete your choice of HIPP
    - State the ONE relevant Synthesis/Historical Connection and explain the connection
    - Answer the provided questions
2. Introduction to Period 2: 1607-1754 (255 points total) **Due: September 14**
  - Read Chapter 2 “The Thirteen Colonies and the British Empire, 1607-1754” and complete the provided notes worksheet. (104 points total)
  - Read Chapter 3 “Colonial Society in the 18<sup>th</sup> Century” and complete the provided notes worksheet. (93 points total)
  - Period 2 Primary Source Documents (58 points total)  
Read the six provided documents and 1 image in order to
    - Complete your choice of HIPP
    - State the ONE relevant Synthesis/Historical Connection and explain the connection
    - Answer the provided questions
3. Complete two Short Answer Questions (SAQ) (30 points total) **Due: September 18**
  - Each SAQ will have three questions, and each question should be answered in two-sentences max. For each question, use the following acronym: ACE
    - Answer the question
    - Cite specific evidence that supports your answer
    - Elaborate to explain how your specific evidence answers the question
