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PARENTAL CONSENT FORM FOR ABBREVIATED SCHEDULES

Seniors who have been approved for abbreviated schedules may arrive late or leave early under the following conditions:

- The student must file this consent form with their School Counselor, who will provide a copy to the front office
- Students arriving after 1st period must enter through the front office and sign in upon arrival
- Students must leave the building through the main office after their last scheduled class of each day and sign out of the building prior to leaving
- Students should not be in the building for long periods of time before or after their course schedule – students with abbreviated schedules should arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before their classes begin and should leave no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of their classes
- Once a student leaves, they may not come back to school during the same day unless special permission has been given and a staff member takes responsibility for their supervision (i.e. SGA, NHS, Peer Leaders, Athletics, etc.)
- Seniors are permitted to volunteer at the Elementary School with prior approval outside of their scheduled class times – this is a good option for students who have early dismissal but need to stay in the area for after-school extracurricular activities
- At no time is a student permitted to leave the building prior to the time indicated on this contract unless dismissed by the office at the time their parent/guardian has arrived to pick them up – student drivers may only leave early with written permission from their parent/guardian
- The privilege of coming late or leaving early can be revoked as a result of disciplinary action, attendance concerns, etc. if needed
- It is the student's responsibility to keep track of early dismissal days and 2-hour delays in the case that their schedule is rearranged – seniors are responsible for attending their classes as scheduled
- Students taking Dual Enrollment courses must respect their CMIT schedule **first** and are not permitted to enroll in classes that conflict with their high school schedule

Please note: on days that are in the PGCPS calendar in advance that rearrange the school schedule (i.e. early dismissals), students are expected to come to school for their scheduled courses even if they are at different times than usual or as indicated in this contract. If there is an unexpected 2-hour delay or early dismissal that is *not* on the school calendar, students will be marked as an unexcused absence if they are not able to make it to school and the decision whether make-up work will be accepted will be under the discretion of the student's teachers for missed classes.
