What application materials are required?	<p>Get writing tips and read essays that worked at apply.jhu.edu/essays</p> <p>You do need to submit a transcript, 2 teacher recommendations, 1 counselor recommendation, 2 essays</p> <p>Hopkins also cares a lot about how you “leave an impact in your community” (which covers extracurricular participation and service hours, and if you support your family, attend religious or cultural events, etc.)</p> <p>Information for Transfer Students</p>
Are you test optional this year?	<p>Test Optional for Class of 2021</p> <p>You can send test scores if you want to - there is no direct advantage for submitting test scores. You are also not penalized for NOT sending scores.</p>
Average Accepted GPA	<p>This is not reported because the applications received vary in GPA measuring. However 99% of students that are accepted report that they are within the top 10% of their high school graduation classes.</p>

Parking for Freshmen?	Yes - but there is no guaranteed or specific parking lot for students. You don't need parking to get around since there is so much public transportation and everything on campus is walkable.
Housing Information	<p>Housing is Guaranteed and Required for the first two years for students.</p> <p>For junior and senior years, housing is not required nor guaranteed and most students live off-campus but closeby!</p> <p>More Housing Information</p>
Any Special notes for COVID-19?	<p>Currently the campus is running as a fully-remote environment for the Fall 2020 term. No decisions have been made for Spring 2021 and forward.</p> <p>The Office of Undergraduate Admissions is also fully closed (in person).</p>
