<b>Are you test optional this year?</b>	<p>Yes: For Fall 2021 applicants  Can submit if you think it will help your application. If submitted they can't unsee it so make sure submission will help and not hurt  2022 NYU may require testing</p>
<b>Average Accepted GPA</b>	<p>3.7 for applicants of 2020 year  Overall performance: Looking to see that you are well rounded</p>
<b>Parking for Freshmen?</b>	<p>Not advised to bring a car  No parking on campus</p>
<b>Housing Information</b>	<p>Guaranteed for all four years at both locations  <a href="#">Housing and Dining at NYU</a></p> <p>Themed floors  Faculty members live in and host events  All bathrooms are in-suite, no communal bathrooms</p>
<b>Any Special notes for COVID-19?</b>	<p>Mixed Mode - 50% of students are on campus but not all are taking classes in person - some classes are fully virtual, some are fully in-person, and some are mixed. Students get to decide what they prefer.  Some students are taking courses virtually through a more localized campus (such as the DC location)</p>
