All of their residence halls have been renovated in the last four years.</p> <p>They also have four Living Learning Communities with 30-50 students. They have Science and Technology, the Schoolhouse for Education Majors, Entrepreneurship, and Are You Makers (for students who like to work with their hands - which has a 3D printer and woodshop in</p>

Dining Options	<p>Dining is included in your room and board costs! There are also several restaurants in the town for students.</p> <p>Radford Dining</p>
Financial Aid Information (Deadlines, Forms, and Special Programs?)	<p>The total cost is \$33,044 for out-of-state students (including tuition, room and board, and meal plan) -- Yet, 78% of students don't pay that amount and receive financial aid or scholarships.</p> <p>There is a Highlander Distinction Program, which provides four-year scholarships. Check it out!</p>
