| <b>Are you test optional this year?</b>         | Always Test Optional!<br><br>Average is 1000-1200 SAT for students who <i>do</i> choose to submit.   |
| <b>Average Accepted GPA</b>                     | 3.5  |
| <b>Parking for Freshmen?</b>                    | Yes - and parking is free!   |

| <b>Financial Aid Information (Deadlines, Forms, and Special Programs?)</b> | <p>When you apply, you are always considered for a Merit-Based Scholarship. ALL admitted students get at least the \$20,000 per year scholarship. If you have at least a 3.0 high school GPA, you will get at least a \$25,000 scholarship.</p> <p>For Need-Based Aid, you need to submit the FAFSA by March 1 (but the earlier you submit, the earlier your financial aid award is made). Financial Aid award letters start coming out in January.</p> |
