AP Biology + Lab	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in related high school courses to include Biology and Chemistry • Can be taken as an elective by 11th or 12th grade students who have already earned 3 Science credits • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current Science Teacher; Math teacher will be consulted by the AP Team
AP Calculus + Seminar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in Pre-Calculus. • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current Math Teacher; Science teacher will be consulted by the AP Team
AP Human Geography + Seminar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in US History, Government, and/or World History. • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current Social Studies Teacher; English teacher will be consulted regarding your writing skills

AP Environmental Science + Lab	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in Biology and Chemistry courses • Can be taken as an elective by 11th or 12th grade students who have already earned 3 Science credits • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current Science Teacher; Math teacher will be consulted by the AP Team
AP World History + Seminar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in High School Level US History and LSN Government. • Can be taken to satisfy the World History graduation requirement. • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current Social Studies Teacher; English teacher will be consulted by the AP Team
AP American Government and Politics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in High School Level US History course • Can be taken to satisfy the Local, State, and National Government graduation requirement. • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current Social Studies Teacher; English teacher will be consulted by the AP Team
AP Statistics + Seminar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in Algebra 2 Common Core, Pre-Calculus, or Trig/Analysis. • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current Math Teacher; Science teacher will be consulted by the AP Team
AP English Language and Composition + Seminar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in English 10. • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current English Teacher; Social Studies teacher will be consulted by the AP Team
AP English Literature + Seminar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in 11th Grade English Course. • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current English Teacher; Social Studies teacher will be consulted by the AP Team
AP Computer Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong performance in Technology Courses • Additional test may be required • Sealed Letter of recommendation must be obtained from current or past Technology teacher; <i>if</i> that teacher is no longer at CMIT, a letter from a Math teacher will be accepted as a substitute
